

# PowerBroker Run Elevated

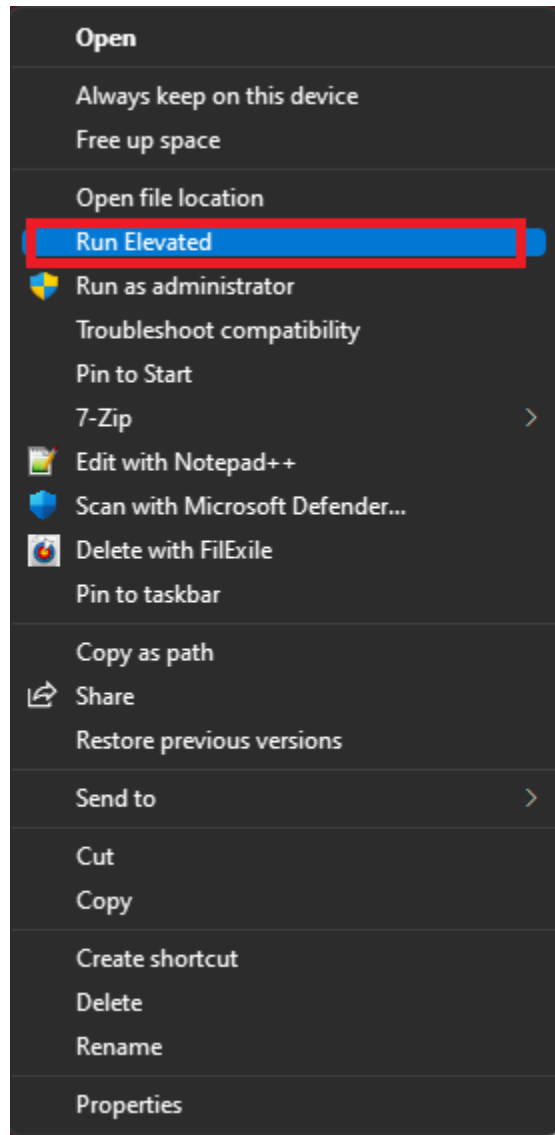
## Installing Applications

A special malware protection mechanism has been installed on ECU laptops. That software, called PoweBroker, provides the security of a limited-user account and the flexibility of elevating to an administrator account on demand.

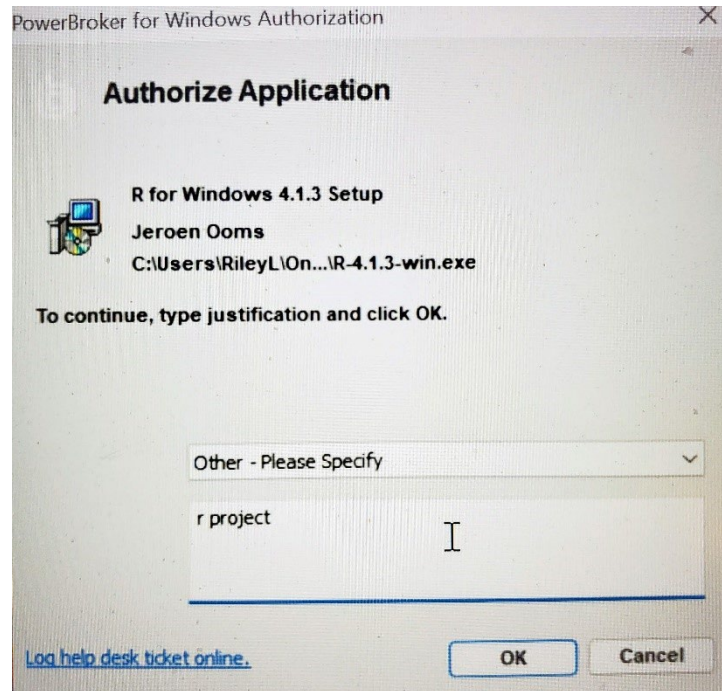
## Installation Method 1: PowerBroker Desktops (Right Click > Run Elevated or Install Elevated)

For machines running Windows 10:

- 1) Download an executable file.
- 2) Right click it and select Run Elevated from the Right Click menu.

  - b. If it is an install file other than an executable, you may see the option Install Elevated instead.
- 3) You will now see the PowerBroker for Windows dialog box.

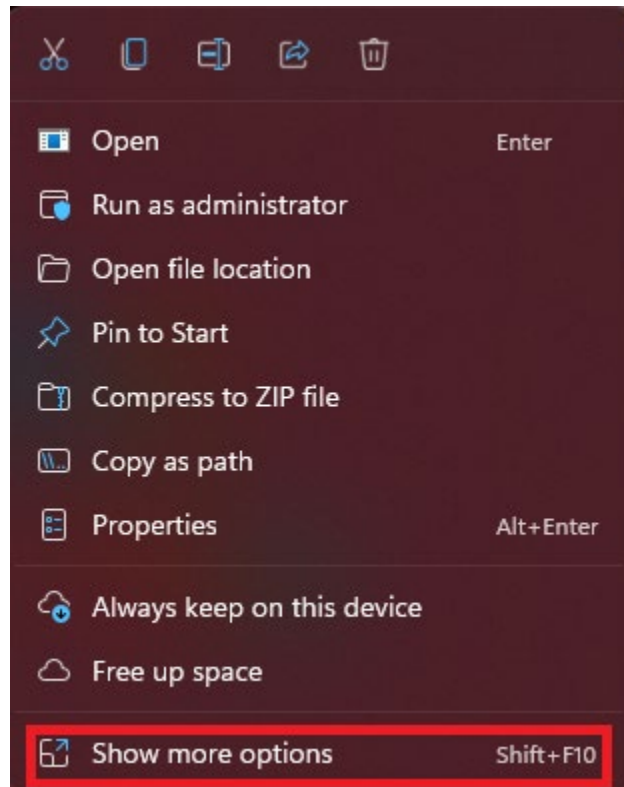

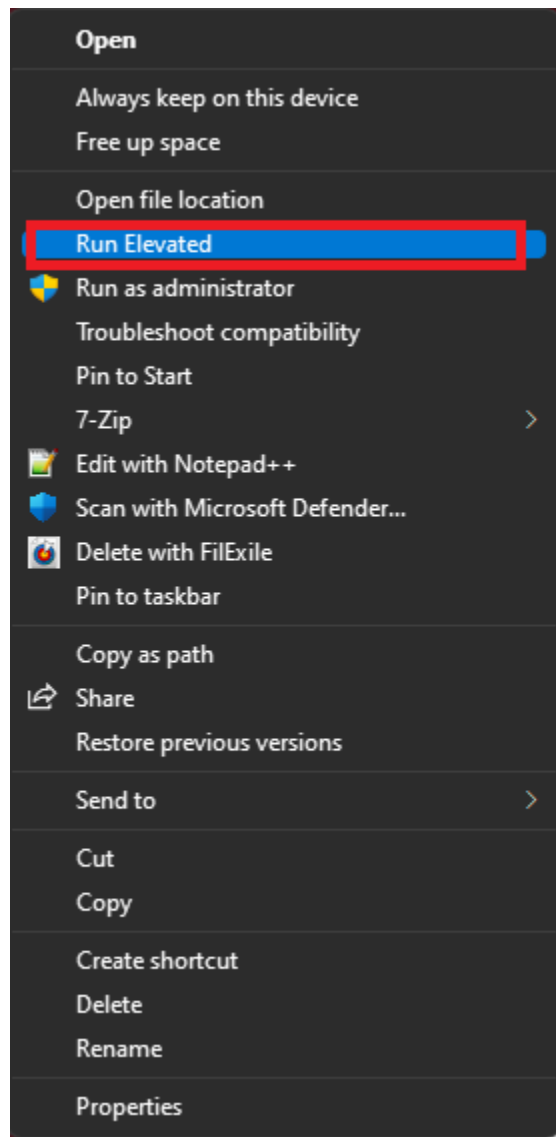
- b. Provide a justification (a few words is okay).
- 4) After you click OK, Windows will continue the installation process.

For machines running Windows 11 the steps are slightly different:

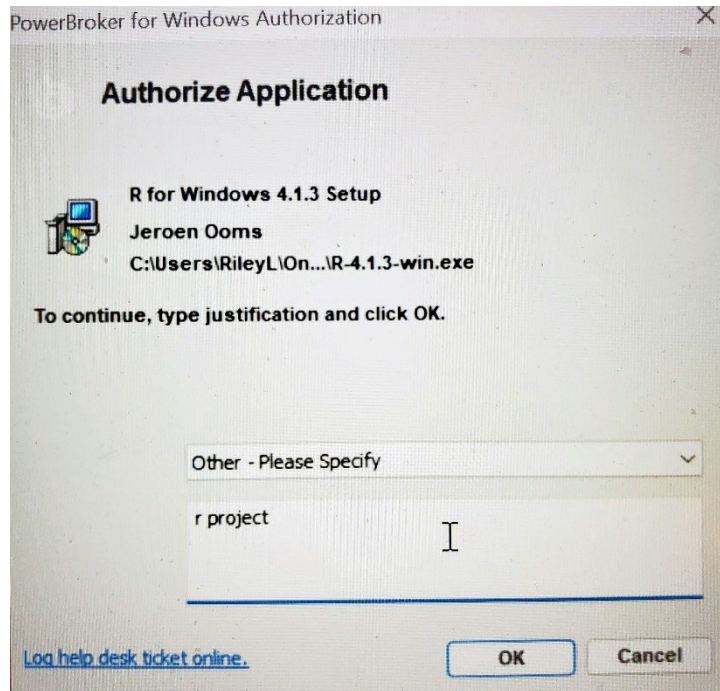
- 1) Download an executable file.
- 2) Right click it and select Show More Options

3) Select Run Elevated

  - b. If it is an install file other than an executable, you may see the option Install Elevated instead.
- 4) You will now see the PowerBroker for Windows dialog box.

5) After you click OK, Windows will continue the installation process.

Note: If updates that occur inside individual programs do not work, uninstall the original application (if applicable) and install the new version according to any of the methods explained here.

## Installation Method 2: Secure Install Folder (C:\Secure\_Install)

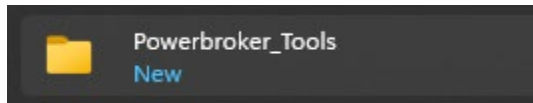
Sometimes the Run Elevated option will not work for a particular program installer. When this happens there is an additional way to attempt to install the program.

To install these applications that fail to install via Run Elevated:

- 1) Copy the executable or other installer file to C:\Secure\_Install
    - a. Open File explorer
    - b. Select Computer
    - c. Select C:
    - d. Open the Secure\_Install directory
    - e. Copy the file to this location
  - 2) Double click the install file.
  - 3) Provide a justification (a few words is okay).

# Uninstalling Software

In order to Remove software installed on your device, click on the Start menu button, click on All Programs, then expand the folders. Locate the folder labeled PowerBroker\_Tools.



Upon launching any of the tools located inside will display the PowerBroker for Windows Authorization dialog box, and prompt you for a justification.

The three options listed inside:

1. Manage Network Settings
  - A. Allows you to enable or disable wired or wireless network connections
  - B. Also allows you to view or change TCP/IP settings
2. Manage Printers
  - A. Allows you to modify settings for printers already configure on your computer
  - B. Allows you to add new printers without using manufacture supplied printer installation programs
3. Manage Programs and Features
  - A. Allows you to uninstall software
  - B. Sometimes allows you to add or remove components to specific software, if the vendor allows
